The purpose of these meeting notes is to help document school and community input into the design process.

- I) Meeting synopsis: a 1% for Art Meeting and Building Design Committee meeting were held to (1) discuss the Art potentials for the school and (2) present & receive feedback on the schematic design.
 - II) 1% for Art meeting (1 pm – 3 pm): This meeting was attended by community members, students, MSB & MSBSD representatives, and the architects. Jocelyn Young coordinated the meeting and presented information on the 1% for art program and process. A good discussion about potential art sites in the building and how to make the art more integrated in the school resolved that a Request for Qualifications would be sent out in January to artists. Selected artists would work with the committee & architect during the design process to refine the placement and integration of the art into the school.

III) Building Design Committee Meeting (3 pm – 4:30 pm): MCG Architects presented the schematic design to the building design committee. It was favorably received with minor comments as follows:

1. Add staff parking, as part of an additive alternate, to accommodate a total staff parking of 30; include provisions for head-bolt headers
2. Move the teaming classrooms closer to the east side of the plan to better accommodate the integration into the middle school curriculum
3. Look at moving one of the resource classrooms further east on the plan to distribute the resource curriculum evenly in the facility

IV) School Board Meeting (6pm): MCG Architects presented the schematic design to the Mat-Su school Board. Additionally, community members from the Su-valley area spoke in support of the schematic design.
